11th - ANNUAL REPORT 2019-20

- ❖ **Before presenting the Annual Report, I would like to pay homage to our Great Guru Late Lamented His Grace Thomas Mar Athanasios, The founder President of the Trust of the Society of St. Basil.**
- ❖ **It is my proud privilege to welcome you all to the 11th Annual Day Celebration of Baselios Public School and present before this august gathering the Annual report for the academic session 2019-20. On behalf of The Society of St. Basil and The Baselios Public School family I, extend a very warm welcome to Honourable Chief Guest Mr. Sudhir Kumar, Executive Director, Gujarat Refinery, Mrs. Shubhra Aggrawal, Mr. Varghese Thomas, Mr. Shaji Mathai, Mr. Jacob Vaidyan Trustees of the Society of St. Basil, Miss Jinal Kapadia, Prime Minister of the school Parliament, Distinguished guests, Principals of our sister schools and other schools, Parents, Teachers and my dear Students.**
- ❖ **The sole aim of our institution is to impart sound education and create intellectually sharp, emotionally balanced and morally sound citizens. Therefore along with academics a wide range of activities are conducted to enhance the moral values, talents and abilities of the students.**
- ❖ **This academic session started on 8th April 2019.**
- ❖ **School Parliament**
 - **Elections for the school parliament were held in the month of June. The students voted for their favourite candidate through Secret Ballot System. Miss Jinal Kapadia and Miss V.S. Bhavani were elected as the School Prime Minister and Deputy Prime Minister respectively. The new cabinet was installed. Rev. Father Dr. M.S. John bestowed the office bearers with Badges and Sashes. Oath was taken and duties were assigned to each member of the school parliament.**
- ❖ **Academic Achievements**
 - **In CBSE Board 2018-19 Std. X examination, we achieved 100% result. 37 students appeared out of which 35 students passed with distinction and first division and two students secured above 55%. Miss Jinal Kapadia stood first with 95.4%, Soumita Saha stood Second with 93.8% and Deep Raut stood third with 92.6% marks.**
 - **I feel proud to share that we presented our first batch of Std. XII Science Stream (2018-19) for CBSE board examination in March 2019. We achieved 100% result. 25 students appeared out of which 23 students passed with distinction & first class and two students above 50%. K. Pallavi stood first with 94% marks, Harshul Upadhyay stood second with 89.8% and Nitya Shah with 87.4% marks.**

- **A Graduation Ceremony for our first batch of Std. XII was organized. Children were felicitated by our Chief Guest Mr. Sudhir Kumar with Graduation Certificates.**
 - **This year we started Std. 11 (Commerce Stream).**
 - ❖ **Orientation with Parents**
 - **Orientation for K.G, Primary and Secondary students was held in the month of June. A detailed power point presentation on remodelled assessment structure was given to the parents of Std. VI to XII Students and made them aware of the new initiative taken by CBSE. A healthy interaction took place with parents & all their queries were answered.**
 - ❖ **Half Yearly and All India Examinations**
 - **In order to prepare the children for competitive exams and gain confidence to be at par with the best students at National and International level, children were encouraged to participate in Science, Mathematics and English Olympiad. This time there was 100% participation in these examination. Children also participated in ‘Talent Search’ exams.**
 - **Summative Assessment of Std. I to Std. V and Half Yearly Exam of Std. VI to XII was conducted and Parent- Teacher contact day and review was held to discuss the results. Project works prepared by the students were displayed and book exhibition was also organized in the school.**
 - ❖ **Competitions**
- The school looks at each learner as a unique ‘whole person’ with inherent genius, special capabilities and unlimited potential. By providing a conducive and encouraging environment the learners are mentored to participate in a variety of intra and inter school activities and competitions. These help them not only to showcase their talents, hone their skills but these also entail opportunities that lead to multi-dimensional growth of their physical, social, intellectual and spiritual being.**
- **Our students are divided into four houses namely Red, Blue, Green and Yellow. Inter House competitions are organised throughout the year to develop a variety of skills with competitive spirit.**
 - **They also get the opportunity to participate in all the inter-school competitions held by Sahodaya Central Gujarat CBSE schools.**

- **Inter House Singing Competition was held for the KNT Namboothiri Trophy. A choir from each house presented songs on the theme of 'Friends'. Trophy was bagged by Blue house.**
- **Inter House Folk Dance competition was also held and the first prize was bagged by Blue House.**
- **An Extempore speech competition was held for the students of Std. V to XII. Topics were given to each participant half an hour before the event. This Activity helps the students to speak fluently with confidence. Vruta Patel of Std. VIII in Junior Group and Jinal Kapadia of Std. XI in Senior group won the first prize in this event.**
- **To inculcate interest in Mathematics and judge the mental ability of students, Mental Maths competitions were held.**
- **Inter House G.K. quiz competition held for Kalpana Dutta Rolling Trophy for Junior Group was won by the team of Green house and the BPS Rolling Trophy for Senior Group was won by Blue house.**
- **Competitions were held for Best out of waste and Collage making.**
- **Hindi week was celebrated in the month of September. Various competitions were held like Debate, Poem Writing, Essay Writing, Poem Recitation, Storytelling and Handwriting competitions. Children participated enthusiastically and the prize winners were felicitated at Kundan Hall by Mr. Tamboli, GM (HR), Gujarat Refinery.**
- **Our children also participated in various Inter school Quiz competitions organized by Baroda's various schools and organizations.**
- **Inter House Essay competition in English was held for both Junior and Senior group and in Junior group the Rolling trophy went to Yellow House and for Senior group to Red house.**
- **A debate competition was held for the Alka Smart Rolling Trophies which were bagged by V.S. Bhavani of Std. XI in Senior group and Vruta Patel of Std. VIII in Junior group.**
- **An Elocution competition was organized by IOCL to create awareness amongst students about the role of preventive vigilance in reducing corruption. The topic was "Integrity the Way of Life" Ketan Kumar of std. IX bagged the first prize and Vruta Patel of Std. VIII got Second prize.**

- **An Inter house cooking competition was held and The Naval Kishore Jani Rolling Trophy for culinary excellence was bagged by the Master Chefs of Red House. Mrs. Subhra Agrawal The First lady of the Township judged the students on various culinary skills and also gave some tips on nutrition.**
- **Our school hosted the prestigious 36th Inter-School Debate Competition for Baslios Rolling Trophy. 16 Schools participated in this competition. V.S. Bhavani of Std. XI stood I in Senior group and 2nd Runner Baslios Rolling trophy was bagged by our school.**
- **As part of 150th Birthday celebration of Gandhiji on 2nd October, various activities were organized in school. Pledge was taken on cleanliness. A Quiz and Poster making competition was conducted on the life of Mahatama Gandhi. The school premise was cleaned by the students and the staff of the School. And then they participated in Fit India Plogging Run.**
- **Our students from Std. 1 to 11 participated in English Literature Bonanza held at Navrachana International School. In which various competitions were held related to English Literature.**
- **Our students participated in various Inter-School Science Exhibition organized by CBSE and Podar World School. Ms. Dhruvi Parmar and Ms. Sanjana Mahawer of Std. IX bagged the 2nd Runner Up Inter School Scipotech trophy in Senior group.**
- **Thilika of Std. VII got first position in Inter School Painting competition which was held at Anandalya School, Anand. The topic was ‘Save Water’.**
- ❖ **K.G. and Junior Primary Week**
- **K.G. and Junior Primary Week was organized on 23rd October 2019, during which the students had a week long program of fun, competitions, film show and field trip. The week ended with a cultural programme presented for parents on the theme of ‘Glimpses of India’. The Chief Guest, Mrs. Shubra Agrawal awarded prizes to the Winners of all the competitions.**
- ❖ **Sports and Games**
- **The domain of sports has the vast potential to “better” the game of life itself. Besides promoting physical fitness, it lays importance on healthy lifestyle and helps in developing social skills. Sports play a pivotal role in instilling among our impressionable learners, values that would hold them in good stead throughout their lives, such as, discipline, perseverance, team spirit, sportsmanship etc.**

- Various Inter- House events were held this year like Cricket, Badminton, Kabaddi, Volley ball, Kho-Kho, Handball, Throw ball and Indoor games like Dart Board competition, Chess, Carom, Table Tennis.
 - Dhaval Namjoshi Trophies for these events were won by different Houses.
- 11th Annual Sports day was celebrated on 23rd November 2019 with a spectacular March Past and drills. Red House secured the highest points and was the winner. The Champion of Champions trophy for boys was bagged by Kirti Raj of Std. XI and for girls Mukti Trivedi of Std. X. Mr. Sudhir Kumar, Executive Director, Gujarat Refinery was the Chief guest.
- The Trust of the Society of St. Basil from this year started Inter School Football & Badminton Tournaments in the Memory of Late Lamented Bishop Thomas Mar Athansios, in which all the schools of The Trust participated. Mar Athanasios Memorial Rolling Trophies for Inter School Badminton and Football Championship were won by our school.

❖ Festivals & Celebrations

- Children celebrated World Environment Day on 5th June. Pledge was taken by students to protect natural resources, minimize its wastage and create awareness among fellow beings. Saplings were also planted in the school campus marking the importance of the healthy and green environment. The theme was “Beat Plastic Pollution”.
- A Rain water harvesting plant was installed in the school campus with the help of CISF. A pledge was taken in the morning assembly to conserve water and a Nukad Natika was also performed by the CISF personal on water conservation and saplings were also planted in the school premises.
