- ❖ Before presenting the Annual Report I would like to pay homage to our Great Guru Late Lamented His Grace Thomas Mar Athanasios, The founder President of the Trust of the Society of St. Basil, who left for heavenly abode on 24 August 2018. May God have him in his glory and give him rest for all eternity.
- ❖ It is my proud privilege to present the Annual report for the academic session 2020-21. On behalf of The Society of St. Basil and The Baselios Public School family I, extend a very warm wishes to everyone.
- ❖ The nationwide lockdown following the COVID-19 pandemic has led to online education. The COVID-19 has resulted in schools shut all across the world globally. As a result, education has changed dramatically, with the distinctive rise of e-learning, whereby teaching is undertaken remotely and on digital platforms.
- ❖ At Baselios Public School teachers are regularly in contact with the students and parents and taking the online classes regularly. Apart from this, students are given various other extra-curricular activities on day to day basis which they can carry out at their home.
- ❖ The sole aim of our institution is to impart sound education and create intellectually sharp, emotionally balanced and morally sound citizens. Therefore along with academics a wide range of activities are conducted to enhance the moral values, talents and abilities of the students.
- ❖ This academic session started online on 7th April 2020 with the blessings of Late Lamented His Grace Thomas Mar Athanasios.
- ❖ **Academic Achievements**
  - In CBSE Board 2019-20 Std. X examination, we achieved 100% result. 34 students appeared and all students passed with distinction and first division. Miss Khushboo Arora stood first with 92.8%, Miss Prapti Alva, Miss Sonia Thorat and Miss Khushi Nayak stood Second with 92% and Master Hitesh Dangi stood third with 91.2%.
  - I feel proud to share that Std. XII (Science) 2019-20 we achieved 100% result. All students passed with distinction & first class. Shikha Dwivedi stood first with 90.4% marks, Sania Parween stood second with 89.4% and Kinjal Singh secured third with 87.8% marks.
- ❖ **Online Orientation programme with Parents**
  - Online Orientation for Secondary students was held in the month of June. A detailed power point presentation on remodelled assessment structure was given to the parents of Std. IX to XII Students and made them aware of the initiative taken by CBSE. A healthy

online interaction took place with parents & all their queries were answered as now in the present scenario parents support and monitoring is required as children are learning from home.

### ❖ **Half Yearly and All India Examinations**

➤ In order to prepare the children for competitive exams and gain confidence to be at par with the best students at National and International level, children were encouraged to participate in Online Science, Mathematics and English Olympiad. Children also participated in ‘Talent Search’ exams held by Discovery channel and Byju. Our students also participated in various exam organised by International Olympiad Foundation and NELTAS(English language skills development programme)

❖ **Periodic Tests** for all the classes were conducted through Google form, Google Meet and Zoom.

❖ **Summative Assessment** of Std. I to Std. V and **Half Yearly Exam** of Std. VI to XII was conducted and Result was declared Online.

### ❖ **Competitions & Activities**

The school looks at each learner as a unique ‘whole person’ with inherent genius, special capabilities and unlimited potential. By providing a conducive and encouraging environment the learners are mentored to participate in a variety of intra and inter school activities and competitions. These help them not only to showcase their talents, hone their skills but these also entail opportunities that lead to multi-dimensional growth of their physical, social, intellectual and spiritual being. All the competitions and activities were conducted on virtual mode.

➤ Children got the opportunity to participate in all the inter-school competitions held by Sahodaya Central Gujarat CBSE schools.

➤ An **Elocution Competition** was organized Online by IOCL as a part of Vigilance Awareness Week. The topic was **“Vigilant India Prosperous India”** Anshika Jajoo of Std. XI (Commerce) bagged the first prize. Our Children also took pledge to eradicate corruption.

➤ An **Extempore Speech Competition** was held online for the students of Std. V to XII. Topics were given to each participant half an hour before the event. This Activity helps the students to speak fluently with confidence.

➤ To inculcate interest in Mathematics and judge the mental ability of students, Online **Mental Maths competition** for std.1 to std. XII was held and winners names were announced.

- An Online **G.K. Quiz Competition** was held for Junior Group (V to VIII) and Senior Group (IX to XII). Miss Sampriti Sahu and Miss Vishwambari of class VII won the prize in Junior Group. Master Hitesh Dangi of std. XI and Miss Jinal Kapadia of std. XII won the prize in Senior Group.
- Our children also participated in **Heritage Quiz** organised by CBSE.
- **Hindi week** was celebrated online in the month of September. Various competitions were held like Debate, Poem Writing, Essay Writing, Poem Recitation, Storytelling and Hand writing competition. Children participated enthusiastically.
- Competitions were held for **Best out of Waste and Collage making**.
- **Essay Writing Competition** in English was held on Virtual mode for both Junior and Senior group. The topic for Junior Group was “Is online learning Fun” and for Senior group was “Covid-19 The New Normal”.
- An Online **School Debate Competition** was conducted for Junior Group (Std. V to Std. VIII) and Senior Group (Std. IX to Std. XII).

- Miss Sanjana Mahawar of Std. X and Miss Thilika of Std. VIII were qualified for State Level **Painting Competition on Environment** organised by Petroleum Conservation Resource Association.

### ❖ **K.G. and Primary Week**

- **K.G. and Junior Primary Week** (Std. I to Std. IV) was organized during which the students had a week long program of fun and various competitions like Poem recitation, Story Telling, Drawing, Clay moulding, Singing, Good handwriting , Fashion Show and Fancy dress. Due to pandemic all the competitions and activities were conducted Online.
- **Talent Hunt Week** was conducted for std. V to Std. VIII in which various activities like Good Hand Writing, Card Making, Fancy Dress, Best Out of Waste, Dance, Drama and Singing were conducted online. Children participated in all the activities enthusiastically and they enjoyed a lot.

- The domain of sports has the vast potential to “better” the game of life itself. Besides promoting physical fitness, it lays importance on healthy lifestyle and helps in developing social skills. - **“Fit India Week”** was celebrated Online from 23<sup>rd</sup> November 2020 to 28<sup>th</sup> November 2020 which was aimed to encourage people to inculcate physical activity and sports in their everyday lives and daily routine.
