- I would like to pay homage to His Holiness Moran Mar Baselios Marthoma Paulose II, Supreme Head of the Indian Orthodox Church and a Trustee of the Trust of the Society of St. Basil and Late Mr. Jacob Vaidyan, the trustee of the Trust of the Society of St. Basil, who left for heavenly abode. May God have them in his glory and give them rest for all eternity.
- It is my proud privilege to present the Annual report for the academic session 2021-22. On behalf of The Society of St. Basil and The Baselios Public School family I, extend a very warm wishes to everyone.
- The nationwide lockdown following the COVID-19 Pandemic has led to Online Education. The COVID-19 has resulted in schools shut all across the world globally. As a result, education has changed dramatically, with the distinctive rise of e-learning, whereby teaching is undertaken remotely and on digital platforms, though the school opened for few months with both Online and Offline option.
- At Baselios Public School teachers are regularly in contact with the students
 and parents and took both Online and Offline classes simultaneously. Apart
 from this, students are given various other extra-curricular activities on day to
 day basis which they can carry out at their home and few activities were held
 at school also.
- The sole aim of our institution is to impart sound education and create intellectually sharp, emotionally balanced and morally sound citizens. Therefore along with academics a wide range of activities are conducted to enhance the moral values, talents and abilities of the students.
- This academic session started online on 1st April 2021 with the blessings of Late Lamented His Grace Thomas Mar Athanasios.

• Academic Achievements

- In CBSE Board 2020-21 Std. X examination, we achieved 100% result. 32 students appeared and all students passed with distinction and first division. Master Avinash Shukla stood first with 94.6% marks, Miss Ritti Patel stood Second with 93.4% marks and Master Aaron Joji stood third with 92.8% marks.
- I feel proud to share that Std. XII (Science) 2020-21 we achieved 100% result. All students passed with distinction & one student with first class. Miss Bhavani Vajjala stood first with 94% marks, Miss Pragnya Priyadarshini stood second with 93% and Miss Jinal Kapadiya stood third with 91.8% marks.
- We presented our first batch of Std XII (Commerce) 2020-21 also. All students passed with distinction and first division Master Hariom Kumar stood first with 94.4% marks, Master Zala Ruturaj Singh stood Second with 90.6% marks and Miss Aesha Umesh Kumar Shah stood third with 82.6% marks.

• Online Orientation programme with Parents

Online Orientation for K.G, Primary and Secondary students were held in the month of June. A detailed power point presentation on assessment structure was given to the parents of Nursery to XII Students and made them aware of the new initiative taken by CBSE. A healthy interaction took place with parents & all their queries were answered as now in the present scenario parents support and monitoring is required as children are learning from home.

• Half Yearly and All India Examinations

In order to prepare the children for competitive exams and gain confidence to be at par with the best students at National and International level, children were encouraged to participate in Online Science, Mathematics and English Olympiad. Children also participated in 'Talent Search' exams held by Discovery channel and Byjus'. Our students also participated in various exam organised by International Olympiad Foundation and NELTAS (English language skills development programme).

• Periodic Tests for all the classes were conducted through Google form,

Google Meet and Zoom and few tests were conducted Offline also.

• <u>Summative Assessment</u> of Std. I to Std. IV and <u>Half Yearly Exam</u> of Std. V to XII was conducted and Result was declared Online.

Competitions & Activities

The school looks at each learner as a unique 'whole person' with inherent genius, special capabilities and unlimited potential. By providing a conducive and encouraging environment the learners are mentored to participate in a variety of intra and inter school activities and competitions. These help them not only to showcase their talents, hone their skills but these also entail opportunities that lead to multi-dimensional growth of their physical, social, intellectual and spiritual being. All the competitions and activities were conducted on virtual mode.

- Children got the opportunity to participate in all the inter-school competitions held by Sahodaya Central Gujarat CBSE schools.
- An <u>Elocution Competition</u> was organized Online by IOCL as a part of Vigilance Awareness Week. The topic was <u>"Self Reliance with Integrity"</u> Hitesh Dangi of Std. XII (Science) bagged the first prize, Vruta Patel of std. X stood Second and Nishant Ranjan of Std. VII bagged the Third position. Our Children also took pledge to eradicate corruption.
- An Extempore Speech Competition was held online for the students of Std. V to XII. Topics were given to each participant half an hour before the event. This Activity helps the students to speak fluently with confidence. In Junior group Mitali of class VI stood first, Bhoomi Mate of Std. VII stood second and Hiya Heer of std.VII stood Third. In senior group Khushi Naik of Std.12 and Aman Channa of Std. X bagged First prize and Hitesh Dangi of Std. XII (Sci.) stood Second and Vruta Patel of Std. X stood Third.
- To inculcate interest in Mathematics and judge the mental ability of students,
 Online <u>Mental Maths competition</u> for std.1 to std. XII was held and three
 winners names were announced from each class and were felicitated with ECertificates.
- An Online <u>G.K. Quiz Competition</u> was conducted Online to enhance general knowledge level of the students the competition was held for Junior Group (V

to VIII) and Senior Group (IX to XII). Miss Vishwambari of class VIII won First prize and Mitali Gowda of Std.VI won Second prize in Junior Group. Arushi of class IX won First prize Hitesh Dangi of std. XII won Second prize and Anushka Sharma of class XII won Third prize in Senior Group.

- <u>CBSE Heritage India Quiz</u> is conducted every year to raise the awareness about the preserving human heritage, diversity and vulnerability of the India's built monuments and heritages sites to motivate the future generation of this country towards efforts required to protect and conserve our vast cultural heritage. Our children participated in <u>Heritage Quiz</u> organised by CBSE Online.
- <u>Hindi Week</u> was celebrated online in the month of September. Various competitions were held like Debate, Poem Writing, Essay Writing, Poem Recitation, Storytelling and Hand writing competition. Children participated enthusiastically. Winners were given E-Certificates.
