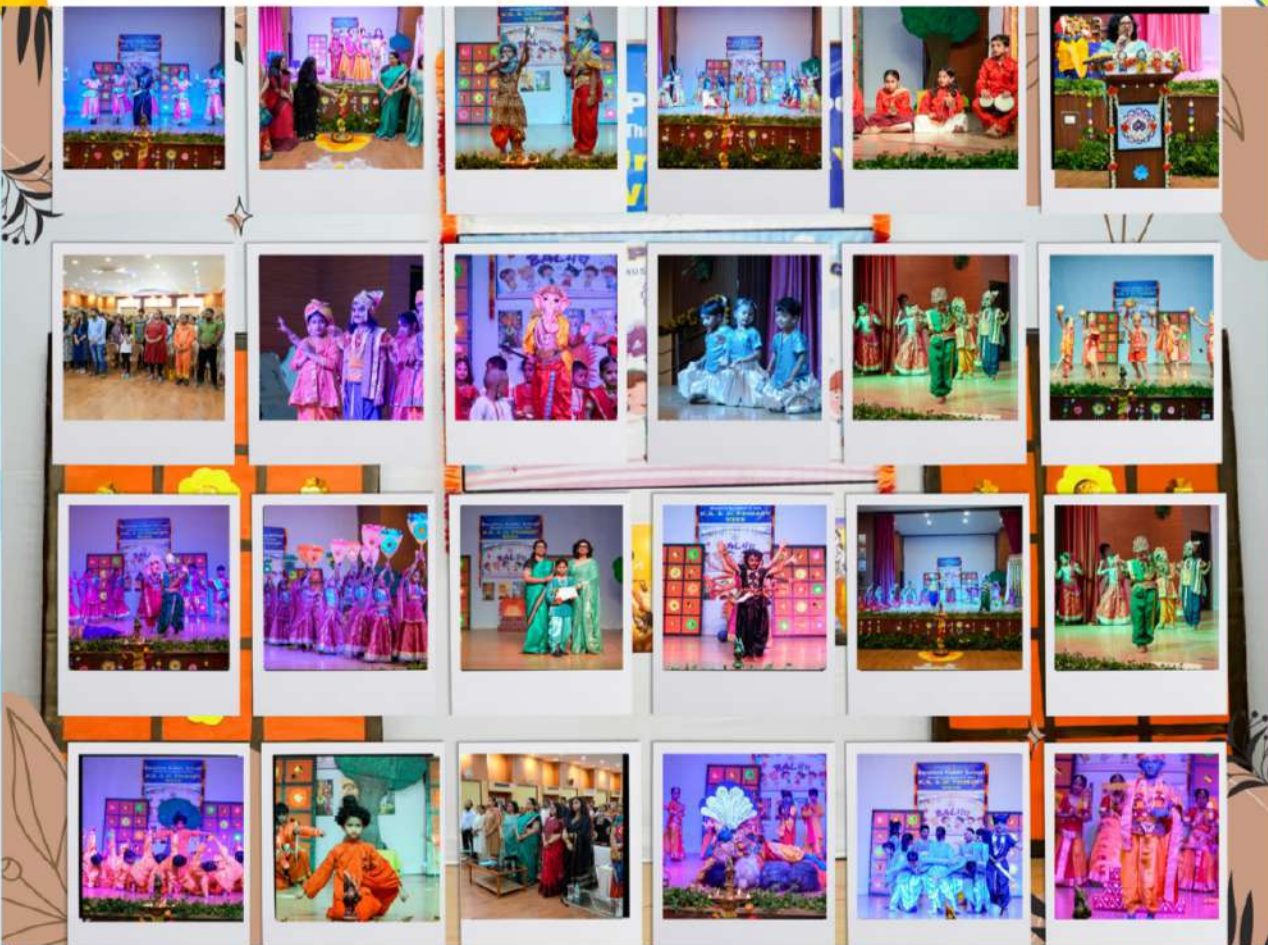
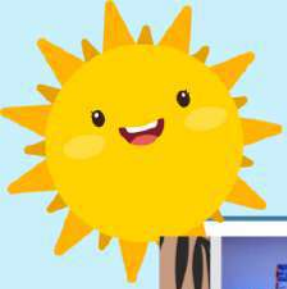

Grade I – Little Cooks Challenge

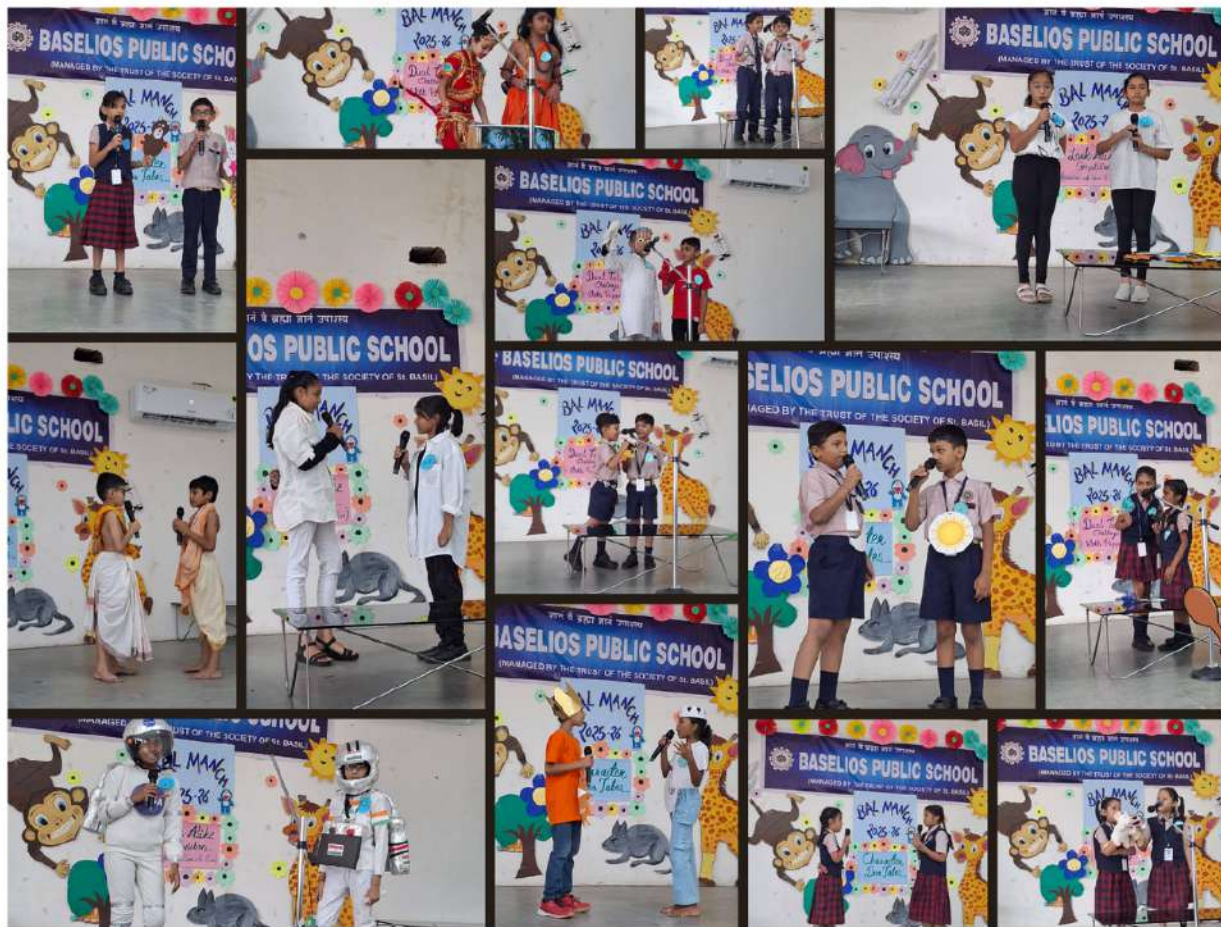
Grade I students prepared simple, colourful, and healthy dishes with great enthusiasm. Their joyful participation filled the room with creativity and flavour.
